2010 Rules & Regulations

1. Registration sheet filled out and signed. Drivers minimum age 16 with guardian consent and farm safety certification.
2. All tractors will cross the scale immediately before they will pull.
3. No alcoholic beverages for drivers.

4. ANTIQUUE CLASS: 1955 and older
Classes: 3500, 4500, 5500, 6500, & 8500

1. 4 mph (maximum speed)
2. 18" Maximum drawbar height
3. Original drawbar
4. ~~Maximum Tire Size 18-4-38~~
5. Maximum Tire Size 18-4-38
6. No T/A, pick 1 gear — (Can't shift during pull)

5. FARM CLASS: 1955 or older with modifications may pull in Farm Class.

Classes: 6000, 8000, 10,000, 12,000, 13,500 (no turbo)

1. 8 mph (maximum speed)
2. 20" maximum drawbar height

6. SPECIAL CLASS: 6200, 9500, 11,000, 26,000 4WD Tractor.

1. Open—no mph
2. 20" Drawbar

7. SPECIAL CLASS: 10,500 Ltd. Hot Farm

1. A maximum of 505 CID which will be certified and oil pan will be tagged and sealed. (09)
2. Intercoolers are not allowed. (09)
3. Maximum Tire Size—20.8 x 42
4. Maximum turbo size of 3" allowed. Map rings are allowed in 2.75" and less. Smooth bore inlet required for 3". (10)
5. Ladder bars are required for 2011. (10)
